

## DOCTRINE

Let us look into the Scriptures about **Doctrine**. God is very strict about His **Doctrine**.

**1. Deuteronomy 32:2:**

*My **Doctrine** shall drop as the rain, My Speech shall distil as the dew, as the small rain upon the tender herb, and as the showers upon the grass:*

**2. Job 11:4:**

*For thou hast said, My **Doctrine** is pure, and I am clean in thine eyes.*

**3. Proverbs 4:2:**

*For I give you good **Doctrine**, forsake ye not My Law.*

**4. Isaiah 28:9:**

*Whom shall He teach knowledge? and whom shall He make to understand **Doctrine**? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts.*

**5. Jeremiah 10:8:**

*But they are altogether brutish and foolish: the stock is a **Doctrine** of vanities.*

**6. Matthew 15:9:**

*But in vain they do worship ME, teaching for **Doctrines** the commandments of men.*

**7. Matthew 16:12:**

*Then understood they how that He bade them not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the **Doctrine** of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.*

**8. Mark 1:27:**

*And they were all amazed, all together that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new **Doctrine** is this? for with authority commandeth He even the unclean spirits, and they do obey Him.*

**9. John 7:16-17:**

*<sup>16</sup> Jesus answered them, and said, My **Doctrine** is not Mine, but His that sent Me.*

***17 If any man will do His Will, he shall know of the **Doctrine**, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of Myself.***

- 10. Acts 17:19:** ***And they took him, and brought him unto Areopagus, saying, May we know what this new **Doctrine**, whereof thou speakest, is?***
- 11. Acts 2:42:** ***And they continued steadfastly in the Apostles' **Doctrine** and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.***
- 12. Acts 5:28:** ***Saying, Did not we straitly command you that ye should not teach in this Name? and, behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your **Doctrine**, and intend to bring this Man's Blood upon us.***
- 13. Romans 6:17:** ***But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of **Doctrine** which was delivered you.***
- 14. Romans 16:17:** ***Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offenses contrary to the **Doctrine** which ye have learned; and avoid them.***
- 15. 1 Corinthians 14:26:**  
***How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a Psalm, hath a **Doctrine**, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying.***
- 16. Ephesians 4:14:** ***That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of **Doctrine**, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness whereby they lie in wait to deceive;***
- 17. 1 Timothy 1:9d-10:**  
***<sup>9d</sup>...for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers.***  
***<sup>10</sup> For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for men stealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound **Doctrine**;***

18. 1 Timothy 4:16: *Take heed unto thyself, and unto the **Doctrine**; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.*
19. 2 Timothy 3:10: *But thou hast fully known my **Doctrine**, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience.*
20. 2 Timothy 3:16: *All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for **Doctrine**, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.*
21. 2 Timothy 4:2-3:  
<sup>2</sup> *Preach the Word; be instant in season , out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and **Doctrine**.*  
<sup>3</sup> *For the time will come when they will not endure sound **Doctrine**; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears.*
22. Titus 1:9: *Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound **Doctrine** both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.*
23. Titus 2:7: *In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works; in **Doctrine** showing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,*
24. Titus 2:1: *But thou speak the things which become sound **Doctrine**.*
25. Titus 2:10: *Not purloining, but shewing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the **Doctrine** of God our Saviour in all things.*
26. Hebrews 13:9a: *Be not carried away with divers and strange **Doctrine**. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace;*
