

## FOUR CORNERS OF THE EARTH

From the May 1, 1971 reading of “Five Minutes with the Bible and Science” comes this statement:

“The Bible is not merely a scientific accommodation to the times in which it was written, but it is timeless in its scientific statements.”

Rev. M. L. Bares of Marietta, Georgia, is quoted in Bible Science News Letter of January 15, 1971, as follows:

“Scientists at John Hopkins Applied Physics Laboratory at Silver Springs, Maryland, learned that the earth is not exactly pear shaped because it has four corners, and is egg shaped at the equator,” thus verifying the statement in:

***Isaiah 11:12: And He shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.***

According to a reprint from APL News (March 1965), Drs. Newton and Guier published papers describing four high points or corners on the earth, each of which covers several thousand square miles.

“One of the high points is in the Northern Hemisphere, centered over Ireland, and sprawls toward the North Pole. Another extends across the equator from New Guinea northward toward Japan. A third is south of Africa centered about half way to Antarctica. The fourth bulge is smaller, fairly round, and lies just off the west coast of South America.

At the center of these high points, the pull of gravity is on the order of 1/50,000 greater than would be expected at mean sea level for the latitude.

Translated into genocidal heights, this means that the recently described bumps average about 60 yards above the mean level surface. Similarly arranged bowls, about as deep as the bumps are high, and separated from them by lines of zero

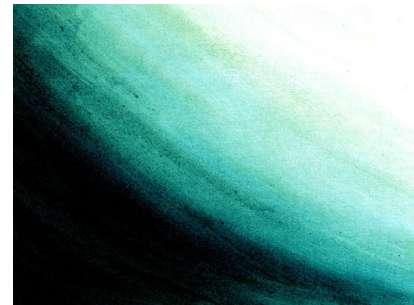
elevation, cover the rest of the world.”

“These facts were learned as scientists measured the deviation in satellite orbits cause by the high gravitational pull of these four corners of the earth.”

For many ages, people believed the earth was flat because the Scriptures said it had four corners. By sailing around the earth, man proved that the earth is round. Isaiah knew this too, because he said:

***Isaiah 40:22a: It is He that sitteth upon the circle of the earth . . .***

***Isaiah 11:12: And He shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.***



***Jeremiah 49:32: And their camels shall be a booty, and the multitude of their cattle a spoil: and I will scatter into all winds them that are in the utmost corners; and I will bring their calamity from all sides thereof, saith the LORD.***

***Jeremiah 49:36: And upon Elam will I bring the four winds from the four quarters of heaven, and will scatter them toward all those winds; and there shall be no nation whither the outcasts of Elam shall not come.***

***Revelation 7:1: And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor the sea, nor on any tree.***

***Revelation 20:8: And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.***
