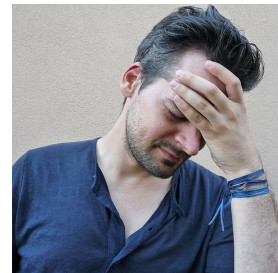


MOSES' MEDICINE CHEST

TEXT: *Exodus 15:26: And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in His sight, and wilt give ear to His commandments, and keep all His statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.*

This is God's Covenant of Healing which was effective "only" upon their obedience to four spiritual laws and regulations. If they would adhere to these standards, it would make them strong spiritually and God also promised to reward them physically. There are no cheap terms or conditions for receiving cures from the Lord. It shows further that most sickness and disease is the result of soul sickness and failing God. God also guarantees freedom from disease that modern medicine cannot duplicate.

Medical science recognizes that emotions such as fear, sorrow, envy, resentment, or hatred are responsible for the majority of our sicknesses. Its estimates vary from 60% to nearly 100%. These emotional turmoils and stresses cause high blood pressures, toxic goiter, migraine headaches, arthritis, apoplexy, heart trouble, gastrointestinal ulcers, and others too numerous to mention.



FEAR *Deuteronomy 1:21: Behold, the LORD thy God hath set the land before thee: go up and possess it, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath said unto thee; fear not, neither be discouraged.*

Deuteronomy 20:3: And shall say unto them, Hear, O Israel, ye approach this day unto battle against your enemies: let not your hearts faint, fear not, and do not tremble, neither be ye terrified because of them;

Deuteronomy 31:6: Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, He it is that doth go with thee; He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

Deuteronomy 31:8: *And the LORD, He it is that doth go before thee; He will be with thee, He will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed.*

Leviticus 19:17: *Thou shalt not hate thy brother in thine heart: thou shalt in any wise rebuke thy neighbour, and not suffer sin upon him.*

Proverbs 24:1: *Be not thou envious against evil men, neither desire to be with them.*

Romans 1:29: *Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers,*



Romans 13:13: *Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.*

2 Corinthians 12:20: For I fear, lest, when I come, I shall not find you such as I would, and that I shall be found unto you such as ye would not: lest there be debates, envyings, wraths, strifes, backbitings, whisperings, swellings, tumults:

1 Timothy 6:4: He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings,



James 3:14-16:

¹⁴ But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.

¹⁵ This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.

¹⁶ For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

James 4:5: Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy?

1 Peter 2:1: Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings,

MEDICAL DIRECTIONS

God gave Moses a number of medical directions which were given to protect the whole camp of the children of Israel.

- ▶ The first was to quarantine those infected with disease to help control the disease.

Leviticus 13:36: All the days wherein the plague shall be in him he shall be defiled; he is unclean: he shall dwell alone; without the camp shall his habitation be.

- ▶ Others were to prevent typhoid, cholera, and dysentery by teaching on sanitation.

Deuteronomy 23:12-14:

¹² Thou shalt have a place also without the camp, whither thou shalt go forth abroad:

¹³ And thou shalt have a paddle upon thy weapon; and it shall

be, when thou wilt ease thyself abroad, thou shalt dig therewith, and shalt turn back and cover that which cometh from thee:

¹⁴ For the LORD thy God walketh in the midst of thy camp, to deliver thee, and to give up thine enemies before thee; therefore shall thy camp be holy: that He see no unclean thing in thee, and turn away from thee.

- ▶ God gave Moses detailed instructions (laws) on the safest method of cleansing the hands after handling the dead or infected living.

Numbers 19:13: Whosoever toucheth the dead body of any man that is dead, and purifieth not himself, defileth the tabernacle of the LORD; and that soul shall be cut off from Israel: because the water of separation was not sprinkled upon him,

In 1960, the Dept. of Health in N.Y. — alarmed at the spread of infectious disease — issued a manual on how to properly wash the hands after centuries of a frightful ignorance that cost the lives of many.



- ▶ Cervical cancer. Thirteen thousand funerals went down our American streets from this particular disease. Many middle-aged women between the ages of 31 and 50 comprise 25% of all the cancers found in women, and 80% of all genital cancers until the early 1900's.

Dr. Hiran N. Wineberg, studying records in Mt. Sinai Hospital, observed that Jewesses were mostly free from this common cancer. Following this lead, Dr. Ira I. Kaplan concluded as to the cause. In 1949, the Mayo Clinic noted that of 568 consecutive cases of cervical cancer, not a single Jew was among the victims. Why? It was due to the God-given instruction to Abraham over 4000 years ago to circumcise the newborn male child.

In 1946, an article in the Journal of American Medical Association brought the safest time for performing this operation. Between 2 - 5 days after birth, the blood clotting vitamin K is not yet formed until 5 - 7 days, so the 8th day — which God told Abraham — is now discovered to be the safest time. The second element also necessary for the normal clotting of blood is prothrombin. On the 3rd day of a baby's life it is only at 30%, but on the 8th day it is at 110%,

the most it will ever be in its life. It levels off to 100% thereafter.

Genesis 17:12: And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which is not of thy seed.

Abraham didn't pick this day through a trial and error method of experiments. It was the day picked by the Creator. Failure to obey this instruction made an Israelite an outcast.

▶ Alcoholism. About 50% of those in mental institutions are there due to alcoholism — man putting an enemy in his mouth to destroy his brain. One of five alcoholics developed partial paralysis of certain muscles, and painful neuritis. Hardening of the liver occurred because the blood from the gastrointestinal tract is prevented from flowing freely through the hardened liver. This results in back pressure in the veins in the lower extremities which become swollen, and the abdominal cavity is so distended with fluid that the victim can scarcely breathe.



We can relieve the acute distress of the huge abdominal cavity by inserting a hollow tube through the abdominal wall and drawing off some of the fluid, but unfortunately the fluid builds up in shorter intervals until the patient succumbs. The obstructed liver also can cause back pressure and ballooning of the veins of the esophagus. These thinned out veins are prone to rupture when food is swallowed and can cause serious or fatal hemorrhage.

Deuteronomy 21:20: And they shall say unto the elders of his city, This our son is stubborn and rebellious, he will not obey our voice; he is a glutton, and a drunkard.

Deuteronomy 29:29: The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this Law.

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
