
### REDEMPTION . . . THROUGH HIS BLOOD

### TEXT:

*Ephesians 1:7: In Whom we have redemption through His Blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His Grace;*

There is freedom from condemnation. For,


# Romans 8:1: There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

There is a pail full of condemnation which hangs over the heads of the souls without Christ. They may realize that there is something wrong with them, but they are not aware of the cause of it all. They cannot be any happier away from the God Who created them for Himself, than a fish can be happy out of water. This is the realm for which they were created. Though they are reluctant to recognize their need of the Saviour, they will rush to the psychiatrist, the doctor, and even notions will strike some to end their misery by suicide.

One's condemnation of soul may bring mental depression; but actually - before God - once one is a condemned criminal, the Spiritual Law of God is that there is a penalty of death. For,

#### Romans 6:23: The wages of sin is death.

There is no excuse for any of you to be lost in sin. God has a pardon for every person who will accept it. It is a pardon signed with the shed Blood of the Lamb of God, and it is offered freely to every lost soul, even the vilest and guiltiest of sinners can be washed clean in the Blood of the Lord Jesus.



I repeat again, God has devised a means whereby one can be reconciled to Him and that is through His Son. Jesus paid the penalty for our sins when He took our sin upon Himself on the Cross. He died on that Cross, was raised from the dead and returned proving victory over death.
