SPIRITUALISM TERMS AND DEFINITIONS

- AEROMANCY: divination by concentrating upon cloud shapes and other atmospheric conditions.
- 2. ALCHEMY: the science of changing the baser elements into gold or silver with the aid of a mysterious psychic substance.
- 3. ALL HALLOWS EVE: October 31 witch festival.
- 4. ALOMANCY: the divination of salt where the diviner casts salt crystals into the air and then interprets the patterns made as the salt falls to the ground or travels through the air.
- 5. AMULET: an ornament inscribed with a magic spell or sign, usually worn around the neck or wrist.
- 6. ANIMISM: the belief that inanimate objects are alive and have souls.


- 7. APANTOMANCY: a method of forecasting using chance meetings with animals, birds, and other creatures. Practiced in various types of Mexican voodoo.
- 8. ASTRAL PROJECTION: the soul leaves the body and travels on a different plane of consciousness.



- 9. ASTROLOGY: fortunetelling by the stars.
- 10. AUGURY: divination from omens and signs.
- 11. AUTOMATIC WRITING: writing under a trance induced by evil spirits or demonic powers.
- 12. BEWITCH: to influence by witchcraft.
- 13. BLACK MAGIC: a form of witchcraft, often called the black arts, using demonic

power or occult forces.

- 14. BOTONOMANCY: divination by burning tree branches, leaves, or herbs.
- 15. CARTOMANCY: fortunetelling by the use of cards.
- 16. CAUSIMOMANCY: divination from watching objects burning in a fire.
- 17. CEPHALOMANCY: divination using the skull or head of a donkey or a goat.
- 18. CERAUNOSCOPY: divination from the study of thunder and lightening.
- 19. CEROSCOPY: divination in which melted wax is poured into cold water.
- 20. CHARM: an ornament believe to contain magical powers.
- 21. CHIROMANCY: divination using lines in a person's hand.
- 22. CLAIRVOYANCE: a medium who forecasts distant happenings through visions.
- 23. CLEROMANCY: akin to divination with dice, but using pebbles or other odd objects.







- 26. COSMIC CONSCIOUSNESS: to be in tune with the universe; an expression used by people spaced out from the use of drugs or meditation.
- 27. COVEN: an assembly of 13 witches.
- 28. CRYSTAL GAZER: a person who uses a crystal ball for divination.
- 29. CULT: a religious group possibly even Christian that is off doctrinally or scripturally, such as satan worshipers or spiritualists
- 30. CURSE: an incantation for harm to come upon someone.



- 31. DEMON: a demonic spirit, an evil attendant power, that is subservient to satan.
- 32. DEMONMANCY: divination summoning or with the aid of demonic spirits.
- 33. DIVINATION: foretelling a future event, or discovering hidden information.
- 34. ESBAT: a witchcraft meeting held for transacting business or to accomplish an act of satanic mischief.
- 35. ESP: the abbreviation for Extra-Sensory Perception. (See definition in No. 37)
- 36. EXORCISM: a ritual used to drive away or evict a demonic spirit from a person or place believed to be possessed by an evil spirit.
- 37. EXTRA-SENSORY PERCEPTION: the ability to gain insights without the use of ordinary senses.
- 38. FAMILIAR SPIRIT: a spirit embodied in an animal which attends, serves, or guards a person; the spirit can also be in the form of a person.
- 39. FETISH: an object regarded as magical or sacred.
- 40. FORTUNETELLER: one who foretells future events for individuals under satanic powers.
- 41. GREY MAGIC: the use of spirits or demon power or occult forces.



- 42. GASTROMANCY: divination using sounds that come from the stomach that are perceived as coming from the dead.
- 43. GENETHLIALOGY: divination by use of the position of the stars at the exact time of one's birth.
- 44. GRAPHOLOGY: the analysis of character through one's handwriting.
- 45. HALOMANCY: divination by salt: same as alomancy.
- 46. HEX: to affect someone by casting an evil spell upon him.

- 47. HOROSCOPE: a diagram showing the position of planets and stars with their signs of the zodiac. Used by astrologers for divination.
- 48. INCENSE: perfumes, herbs, and charcoals burned in rituals.
- 49. LIBRANOMANCY: dates back to pre-Christian times; uses incense as a means of interpreting omens, divination, and invoking evil spirits.
- 50. MAGIC: supernatural power over natural things.
- 51. MEDITATION: fixing your mind on one object for enlightenment by spirits.
- 52. MEDIUM: a person acting as the communicator between this world and the spirit world for the purpose of communicating with someone who is dead.
- 53. METAPHYSICS: pertaining to the cosmos, cosmic energy, and the metaphysical world.
- 54. MYSTIC: one who is into mysticism or the occult.
- 55. MYSTIC CHRISTIANITY: mixing God and satan.
- 56. NECROMANCY: conjuring spirits of the dead to reveal future events or to influence them.
- 57. NUMEROLOGY: divination using vital numbers.
- 58. OCCULT: means "hidden"; secret, mysterious, relating to supernatural forces.
- 59. ONEIROMANCY: divination using one's dreams.
- 60. OOSCOPY: divination by eggs used frequently in a Mexican type of voodoo.
- 61. OUIJA BOARD: a game board used to obtain spiritualistic or telepathic messages about the future or other hidden knowledge from evil spirits.

- 62. PALMISTRY: divination by lines and formation of the hands.
- 63. PHRENOLOGY: divination by head formations.
- 64. PHYSIOGNOMY: character analysis through physical appearance of the features.
- 65. POLTERGEIST: a mischievous ghost said to be responsible for strange noises or the movement of inanimate objects.
- 66. POTIONS: herb mixes, drugs with magical- or drug-state inducing powers.
- 67. PRECOGNITION: discernment about an event not yet experienced.
- 68. PREMONITION: uneasy anticipation of an event.
- 69. PROGNOSTICATION: foretelling the future.
- 70. PSYCHIC: a person sensitive to non-physical forces and the possible significance of them.
- 71. PSYCHIC PHENOMENA: an event that cannot be explained by physical references and are attributed to spiritual forces.
- 72. RECOGNITION: an inner knowledge of things to come.
- 73. REINCARNATION: rebirth of a soul into a new human body or other form of life.
- 74. SABBAT: main meeting of witches to bring in new members.
- 75. SATAN: fallen archangel of God who has set up various types of destruction on earth.
- 76. SATANIC BIBLE: the official Bible of the Church of satan.
- 77. SATANIC CHURCH: refers to any group practicing satanism.
- 78. SATANISM: satan worship or idol worship, usually involving travesty of the Christian rites.

- 79. SCIOMANCY: divination gained through consulting spirits of the dead.
- 80. SEER: one who predicts future events or developments.
- 81. SÉANCE: a group meeting to receive communication from spirits through a medium.
- 82. SOOTHSAYING: the act of foretelling future events.
- 83. SORCERER: a wizard or witch.
- 84. SORCERY: the use of power obtained from being controlled by evil spirits.
- 85. SOUL TRANSMIGRATION: astral projection; transferring of souls from one place to another.
- 86. SPELL: spoken word or pattern of words with magical power using evil spirits.
- 87. SPIRITISM: belief that departed spirits commune with living people, usually through a medium.
- 88. SPIRITUALISM: a type of church organization noted for communicating with the dead.
- 89. SPIRITUALIST: a person involved in spiritualism.
- 90. SPOOK: a spirit, demon, or fallen angel.
- 91. TAROT CARDS: fortunetelling cards.
- 92. TEA LEAF READER: fortunetelling by reading omens in tea leaves.



- 93. TELEPATHY: communication from one mind to another without using physical channels.
- 94. TRANCE: a state of partially suspended animation.
- 95. VIBES: vibrations believed to be set off by body energy.

96. VOODOO: an old form of ritual witchcraft usually similar to black magic rituals.

97. WARLOCK: a male witch.



98. WHITE MAGIC: the use of spirit power to bring about certain reactions: sorcery.

99. WITCH: a woman or man who practices the black arts and other types of the occult.

- 100. WITCH DOCTOR: one who uses herbs or machines to cure ailments believed to be caused by witchcraft in non-medical ways.
- 101. WITCHCRAFT: a type of an occult. The word is often used by the press to denote all occults collectively.
- WIZARD: one who uses spirit power to bring about certain reactions; a sorcerer.
- 103. XYLOMANCY: divination from pieces of burning wood.
- 104. YOGA: exercise and meditation opening the mind to dark powers.
- 105. ZODIAC: an imaginary belt of planets and constellations forming the astrological signs.

All the activities listed above are in some way part of the occult. The word occult means hidden. The devil is very clever. He morphs his identity and masquerades as things we would consider normal, common, or harmless in order to gain entry into our homes and lives. The Word of God clearly warns us that the devil comes to steal, kill, and destroy.

John 10:10: The thief [satan] cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

There are reasons these activities are forbidden. For example, some have

consulted mediums in order to contact a loved one who has died. They will say, "I know that really was my loved one I was speaking with, because he told me things about himself that only he would know." What people do not realize is that the "person" to whom they thought they were speaking was actually the demon that was assigned to their loved one during his lifetime, and therefore knows these details about him. So beware!

Some people like to practice yoga, yet they are unaware that many of the poses are of occult origin. They will tell you they only do the exercises, but are not into the religious side of it. Their mere participation in this activity opens up a gate for the demonic to come into their life and play havoc.¹ Beware!



God is the source of all wisdom. It is an insult to Him to consult a demonic source to get wisdom or counsel when the Bible clearly tells us we can go to Him.

James 1:5: If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

God's counsel is always for our good; the devil's counsel is always for our destruction.

Luke 7:30a: But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves,

To whom will you go for wisdom and counsel?
